The Data Quality Work Group is seeking volunteers for a short-term project with a big payoff—a chance to help develop the data tools used in the field for analysis and decision making. The DQWG Business Intelligence Task Force will help determine the format, design, security and audience for the tool set, which will provide users with the ability to do timely reporting and analysis.

Task force members will meet via WebEx for four to five sessions of an hour to two hours each, beginning in mid-October. Two more representatives are needed, one from a small school district (fewer than 500) and the second from a community college or university. Cumulative ADM Update

The ADM collection has changed for the 2009-10 school year. The new collection is called Cumulative ADM and includes the data for attendance, fall membership, spring membership, early leavers and high school completers.

The data will be collected during four data collection periods during the school year. The first data collection period, identified as the First Period Cumulative ADM, will be from July 1 – October 1.
